- 1) The MHTF Diversity Committee has partnered with MIRACLE Mental Health Inc. (Mental Illness Raising Awareness with Church & Community Leaders Everywhere) as a way to bring diverse perspectives about mental health and the community to this table.

- 2) MIRACLE will address the issues around diversity, inclusion, and equity in the mental health delivery systems in our community.

- 3) MIRACLE Updates:
 - a) Offering CIP (Crisis Intervention Partners) a free training being offered through MATC in Oak Creek Thursday and Friday, November 29th and 30th, 2018, 8am-4:30p. This is a training for persons working in the mental health field (e.g. First responders, case managers, care coordinators, and parole/probation officers). Currently there are 40 people who have signed up for the training. Training is free thanks to a grant. Persons interested can sign up thru MATC portal. CEU's and certificates are available.
 - b) MIRACLE will offer Advanced CIT through MATC at the Oak Creek campus over 25 officers signed up for the class beginning Jan 7, 2019
 - c) Black Men Don't Jump Series had its 3rd workshop last week at MATC- Downtown Campus on Depression and how it affects Black men and other men of color.
 - d) In 2019- MIRACLE is moving forward with prioritizing Advocacy issues- we are organizing and training our members to become effective advocates for relevant community issues.
