

Child Adolescent Psych Crisis Redesign Phase 4 Committee Charter

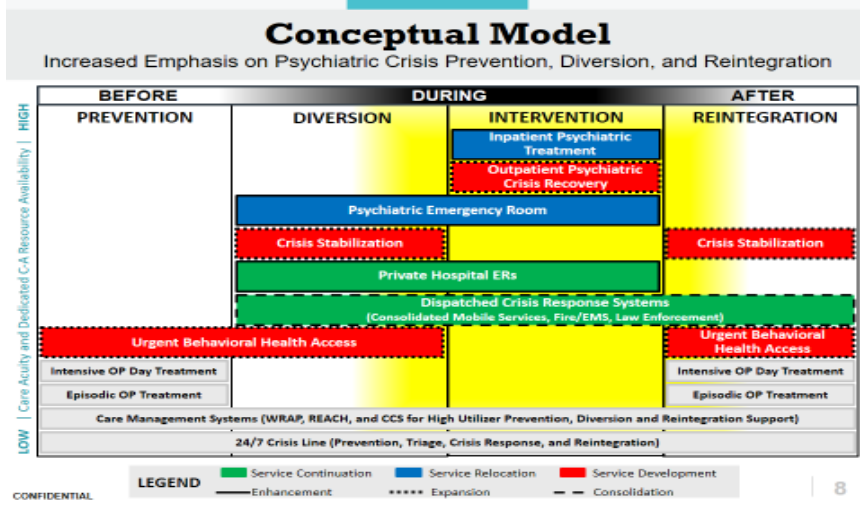
Brief Overview:

This action-oriented oversight committee is charged with transitioning the child adolescent psychiatric crisis redesign conceptual model into the next phase, which includes:

- Monitor public and private C/A crisis services access and performance of current initiatives in Milwaukee County
- Enhance and improve existing public and private C/A crisis programs and services identified as opportunities in the revised conceptual model.
- Prioritize and advance new C/A crisis services aligned with the C/A conceptual model and broader psychiatric crisis redesign
- Inform C/A prevention / early intervention services and supports (out of scope – directed to other org. or groups)

Requirements for Success:

- Intentional private and public collaboration
- Consistent multi-directional communication, including addressing challenges and risks
- Standard approach to identified initiatives to assure consistency
- Development and oversight of necessary subcommittees for implementation
- Shared understanding of creating what youth and families need, vs what we have or think they need
- Clear committee reporting structure and accountability
- Shared responsibility for each other’s success or failure (OUR patient)
- Diverse representation of community we serve



Key Process Steps in Progress

- Creation/Completion of Charter
- Align expected outcomes and deliverables
- Develop top priorities
- Delegate to accountable leaders/subgroups as indicated
