# OUR MODEL

A virtual and physical one-stop shop for tenants and landlords in need of assistance to maintain or provide stable rental housing

Nine co-partner organizations are working together more effectively through the process of developing the RHRC

## OUR Approach

Streamlined intake

A central intake process will allow clients to submit their information to multiple organizations simultaneously **Cross-sector collaboration** Includes many facets of the rental housing system Engaging both tenants and landlords

Acknowledging that both are important to promote and preserve stable housing

#### **RESULTS TO DATE**

\$ 39 million in Emergency Rental Assistance
\$11,115,500 leveraged to support RHRC co-partners since
6/1/20
11,372 households served
6,000 landlords engaged
At least 3500 evictions prevented

### WHAT WE'VE LEARNED SO FAR

Increasing access to rental housing services is best served through coordination

Access to rent assistance is critical

We need one source of **consistent, trusted information** on rental housing **Collaboration** is hard work but ultimately more effective, especially at the systems level

**Communication with landlords** is key to success
