

Advocacy Opportunity: SB-600 Decriminalizing Fentanyl Test Strips (10/12/2021)

This bill decriminalizes the use of fentanyl testing strips to test a substance for the presence of fentanyl. Under current law, fentanyl testing strips are considered drug paraphernalia, and it is a felony for any person to use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia. The bill excepts fentanyl testing strips from the definition of "drug paraphernalia."

Why It's Important

Drug overdoses have been increasing at unprecedented rates in recent years and are now a leading cause of death and driver of reduced life expectancy in the USA. Given the unknown purity and content of illicit street drugs and the evidence that many people who use drugs (PWUD) are uncertain of their exposure to fentanyl before use.

A recent study (FORECAST Study, 2018) found that seventy percent of all respondents reported that knowing that their drugs contained fentanyl would lead them to modify their behavior. This could include not using the drugs, using drugs more slowly, using with others who have naloxone, changing purchasing behaviors.
